Information on the Registration of Vaccination History for those who have Completed Overseas Vaccination to have their Third Vaccination.

Overview

- Foreigners* who have been vaccinated COVID-19 from abroad but there is no quarantine exemption at the time of entry in Korea is can received a third dose in Korea
- * (Foreigners with overseas vaccination) Registration of overseas vaccination history only for those who have a quarantine exemption paper (2021.10.7~)
- Those who have been vaccinated by the USFK* (United States Forces Korea) but have been unable to register their vaccination history due to changes in their affiliation such as retirement is also can register their vaccination history.
 - * (Those who were vaccinated in the U.S. Forces Korea) Issuance of vaccination certificate is after registration of vaccination history in U.S. Forces Korea

Purpose

 Through this measure, foreigners who have registered their first and second vaccination history will be issued a confirmation of overseas vaccination (including COOV) for the COVID-19 vaccine, and can apply for the third vaccination and quarantine pass.

□ Vaccines Can Be Registered

- Only WHO-approved vaccine* applies to vaccination history registration.
- * Pfizer, Janssen, Moderna, AstraZeneca, KoviShield (AZ-India Serum Research Institute), Sinopharm (Beijing), Sinobeck, and Kovaccine
- Foreigners who do not have the quarantine exemption form will have their vaccination history registered in Korea after completing the third vaccination.
- Isolation exemption can also be applied for re-entry and close contact with confirmed patients.

☐ How to register.

 Foreigners who wish to register their overseas vaccination history should bring their ID Cards and Certificates of Vaccination abroad and visit a nearby public health center to register their vaccination history.
